

Greek words translated as “pondering”

Luke 1:29 – “. . . kept *pondering* what kind of salutation this was.”

διαλογίζομαι [*dialogizomai* /dee·al·og·id·zom·ahee/] verb - to bring together different reasons, to reason, revolve in one’s mind

Luke 2:19 - “. . . *pondering* them in her heart.”

συμβάλλω [*sumballo* /soom·bal·lo/] verb - to bring together, to bring together in one’s mind, confer with one’s self
